#### **ABOUT AOPMC 2009**

The Asian and Oceanian Section of the Movement Disorder Society (MDS-AOS) was formed in June 2005. This section is similar to the established European section of the MDS and seeks to reach out to doctors, researchers and healthcare professionals in Asia and Oceanian region. The Asian and Oceanian Section (AOS) of the MDS was officially inaugurated at the  $10^{th}$  International Congress of the Movement Disorders Society in Kyoto, Japan,  $28^{th}$  Oct  $-2^{th}$  November 2006.

To further develop the field of Movement Disorders in the region, the MDS-AOS organizes the Asian and Oceanian Parkinson's disease and Movement Disorders Congress (AOPMC) every 2 years. The first congress was held in Singapore in Oct 2007. The 2 AOPMC will be held in New Delhi, India on February 15 – 17, 2009.

#### **MAIN ORGANIZERS:**

The main organizer of the Congress will be the MDS-AOS. The host organizer will be All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi, India.

#### **PURPOSE:**

The purpose of conducting such a meeting is in line with the objectives of the AOS namely:

- a. Facilitate communication between clinicians and researchers in the region.
- b. Disseminate updated knowledge about Movement Disorders
- c. Improve quality of life and independence of Movement Disorders patients and carers.
- d. Promote research and facilitate research collaborations in Movement Disorders within the region
- e. Expose clinicians, researchers and healthcare professionals in the region to Movement Disorders initiatives and in so doing, encourage their membership in the MDS-AOS.

#### **TARGET AUDIENCE:**

The target participants of this meeting are 600-700 doctors, researchers and healthcare professionals from the region, many of who will not have the opportunity to attend the International MDS meetings as a result of distance, costs and/or visa constraints. Amongst these participants will be many opinion leaders and key Movement Disorders specialists from the region.

#### **SCIENTIFIC PROGRAMME:**

The main congress will be held over 1 ½ days, from 16 - 17 February, 2009 and will consists of plenary sessions, video presentations, research (platform and poster) sessions. It will cover the whole spectrum of Parkinson's disease and Movement Disorders from basic science to clinical practice.

Pre-congress industry sponsored kick-off seminars will be held the day preceding the congress, i.e. 15 February 2009. MDS - AOS initiated educational courses will be conducted on the afternoon of 17 Feb, 2009. The intention of conducting these courses is to formulate course material relevant to the region and to develop a faculty from the region who will be able to run similar educational courses in the region in the future.

This congress will run concurrently with an established regional meeting – the 7 International Symposium of the Asian and Pacific Parkinson's Association (APPA). The 7 APPA meeting in New Delhi, India will include another 400-500 patients, carers, nurses, and allied health professionals. The 7<sup>th</sup> APPA will be organized by the Parkinsonism and Related Disorders Awareness Network (PRAN), India and the All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), New Delhi, India.

Participants will be invited to submit abstracts relevant to the various fields associated with Movement Disorders.
